Dear Parents, thank you all for a wonderful school year so far. If your child is returning for the summer we have planned many fun activities for the students to enjoy. Please make sure registration fees for the session are complete whether it is for summer, fall, or both. Tuition fees are the same as during the school year. During the Summer Program we will be focusing on enriching our community, literacy, science, art, geography, nutrition, recycling and gardening as accessible ways we can make a difference and impact our society. Students will also learn the positive effects these activities can have on efforts to keep our planet healthy. We will learn about biodiversity and the importance of Earth's ecosystems, life cycles of different types of plants and their seasons, how to reduce waste, what we can reuse, basic gardening skills and so much more!

Summer Program Reminders

Sunscreen & Insect Repellent:

Please remember to put sunscreen and insect repellent on your children before they come to school. For children staying past 3pm, we request that you supply us with these items if needed so we can re-apply them before afternoon play time.

Clothing:

Please label bags and clothing items.

Please make sure children have dressed appropriately for the weather and are wearing proper footwear. Flip flops, crocs, slippers, or boots (including rain boots) are not allowed. All clothing and footwear must be comfortable for your children as they will be active. Sneakers or sandals with a strap on the heel are safest.

Tuesdays - Water Play:

Please bring all children dressed in their bathing suit and cover-up to school with an extra change of clothing (please have your child's name written on the tags). We will not be able to change each child and put on sunscreen before water play starts in the morning. Since we do not allow backpacks, we request that parents bring the dry change of clothes in a clear bag (a Ziploc or a reusable bag if you prefer) with their name on it. Once the children change their clothes, we will put the wet clothing in the same Ziploc bag. Toddlers should be wearing a regular diaper under their swim suit.

Playball will be on Tuesdays:

All tuition must include the added fee of playball of \$75 for the first month that starts the month for all students, then the following month is \$65 per month. This will include the T-shirts and the medals that are given out at the end of the assessment at the end of the school year. The new year for this activity starts in June for all old and new students.

Registration fee for each is \$50.

Ballet and Karate- The fee is \$65 per activity per month.

Table Tennis is scheduled for Wednesdays and the cost is \$65 per month.
